A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the Chesterton High School Debate Team for winning the 1999 Debate State Championship.

*Whereas, Thirty-three (33) high schools competed in three events, Public Policy Debate, Lincoln-Douglas Debate, and Congressional Debate, for the 1999 Debate State Championship;*

*Whereas, Chesterton High School won the State Championship with an overall score of 48 points;*

*Whereas, In sixteen (16) years of competition, Chesterton has won the championship ten times, tied for first twice, placed second twice, placed third once, and placed fifth once;*

*Whereas, In Policy Team Debate, of 55 teams competing, the Chesterton teams were Chris Lowery and Mike Rowe, Joel Cavallo and Paul Babcock, Andre Magana and Christian Nallenweg, and Aaron Dartz and Katie Hurley;*

*Whereas, In Lincoln-Douglas Debate, of 67 debaters competing, Chesterton was represented by Jenny Dagostaro, Amanda Taber, and Matt Gregoline, and Sherry Nelson;*
