Whereas, The Martinsville High School Academic Decathlon Team recently won the Indiana Academic Decathlon competition state championship in the large school division for the second consecutive year;

Whereas, The Academic Decathlon Team will be competing in the national finals in Orange County, California, on April 14 through April 18;

Whereas, There will be 40 states and 2,500 schools competing in the national finals in April;

Whereas, The members of the Martinsville Academic Decathlon Team won 22 individual medals, with every member winning at least one medal;

Whereas, Individual medals were received by Misti Asher, third place in art; Ryan Diseroad, third place in speech, second place in economics and overall, first place in social studies, art, and music; Beth Fulmer, first place in essay; Courtney Sturgeon, third place in interview, art, and overall, first place in music; Nathan Teeters, third place in music, second place in art; Lee Diamond, third place in social studies and music; and Sally Meyer, third place in economics, language/literature, and music, second place in social studies, and first place in art and overall;



Whereas, Martinsville High School has had seven state championships in academic competitions since 1994, more than any other high school in the state;

Whereas, This victory for the Martinsville Academic Decathlon Team was truly a community effort with 10 to 15 high school staff members serving as academic coaches, 20 community leaders who interviewed and questioned the team members, and 10 to 15 people who listened to the practices; and

Whereas, The people of the state of Indiana take great pride in the academic accomplishments of the students of our state: Therefore,
