Whereas, Bobby G. Slusher, born October 27, 1923 in Walton, Indiana, was a lifelong resident of Walton until his passing on January 29, 1999;

Whereas, Bobby served his country honorably in the United States Navy during World War II;

Whereas, Bobby continued to support other military people in service to their country, as a life member and past commander of American Legion Post 418, and a life member of Veterans of Foreign Wars 3790 in Logansport;

Whereas, Bobby was a devout man, having achieved the thirty-second degree in Walton Masonic Lodge Post 427, and actively participating in the Scottish Rite of Indianapolis;

Whereas, Bobby was a devoted husband to Gladys Rodgers Slusher for over 52 years, and a loving father to daughters Jeanne, Kathy, Cindy, and also loved daughter
