A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION congratulating the Clinton Prairie girls' basketball team on its recent IHSAA Class A state championship.

Whereas, On Saturday March 13, 1999, in Market Square Arena in Indianapolis, Indiana, the Clinton Prairie Gophers from Frankfort, Indiana, won the IHSAA Class A Girls' Basketball State Championship over New Washington High School;

Whereas, The final score was 50 - 42;

Whereas, This was the first appearance in the state basketball finals for the Clinton Prairie Gophers, although several members of the team are familiar with the pressure placed upon teams in state competitions because they were members of the Clinton Prairie volleyball team that won the state volleyball championship the past two years;

Whereas, Clinton Prairie is only the third school in Indiana history to win state volleyball and basketball titles in the same school year, and Head Coach Connie Garrett, who coaches both sports, is the first coach to win both championships in one year;

Whereas, Senior Kourtney Mennen led the team in scoring with 23 points, but it was her outstanding defensive play that helped Clinton Prairie bring home its first basketball championship;

Whereas, Clinton Prairie finished its season with a 25 - 2



record and won 19 consecutive games; and

Whereas, This victory for the Clinton Prairie Gophers cannot be attributed to one single player. Every member of the team contributed to this magnificent victory and remarkable season: Therefore,
