Whereas, Jason Gardner earned the prestigious title, 1999 Indiana "Mr. Basketball", culminating a tremendously successful high school basketball career;

Whereas, During his senior year, Jason Gardner lead the North Central High School basketball team to victory twenty-five times during a thirty game season, averaging 22.6 points per game;
