A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION commemorating the
Community Plunge Program at Taylor University

Whereas, The Community Plunge Program at Taylor University was instituted in 1993 as a means to create a tangible way for students to express their appreciation to the Town of Upland, Indiana, and build stronger community relationships;

Whereas, In the Fall of 1998 the 5th Community Plunge Program was held and involved approximately 350 of the School's freshman along with several dozen upperclassmen, faculty and staff members;

Whereas, The volunteers wash windows, sweep floors, plant flowers, mow yards, pick up trash, and paint buildings and fire hydrants in parks as well as other town-owned buildings throughout the community;

Whereas, The Community Plunge Program began five years ago as a part of freshman orientation and has served as a wonderful means to build pride and togetherness among students and townspeople;

Whereas, Taylor University started this Program, and continues on under the guidance of Donna Downs - Director of Community Relations for the University, to reinforce from the first
