A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION memorializing Cletus Robert Edmonds, Jr.

*Whereas, Cletus Robert Edmonds, Jr. died on Monday, April 12, 1999, at the age of 53;*

*Whereas, Cletus Robert Edmonds, Jr. was born on June 12, 1945, in Fort Wayne, Indiana;*

*Whereas, Cletus Robert Edmonds, Jr. graduated from Central High School and attended Loyola University;*

*Whereas, Cletus later graduated from St. Francis College in Fort Wayne, Indiana;*

*Whereas, Cletus was a U.S. Army Vietnam War era veteran and was the former commander of the American Legion Post 148;*

*Whereas, Cletus became Labor Relations Director at International Harvester and helped displaced workers find new jobs when the plant closed;*

*Whereas, Cletus also served as Labor Relations Director for the city of Fort Wayne and as Vice President and Loan Officer at Family Mortgage Company;*

*Whereas, Cletus was appointed to the Fort Wayne City Council in 1989 to finish the term of another member and was reelected in 1991 and 1995; and*



*Whereas, Cletus Robert Edmonds, Jr. will be greatly missed by family, friends, and members of his community whose life he so enriched: Therefore,*

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the Senate concurring:*

1           SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly wishes to express  
2 its heartfelt sympathy to the family of Cletus Robert Edmonds, Jr. and  
3 to acknowledge all the contributions Mr. Edmonds made to the Fort
