A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the legislative council to add issues dealing with prosecuting attorney pensions to the charge of the pension management oversight commission.

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives  
of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,  
the Senate concurring:*

- 1           SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to add the  
2 following issues dealing with prosecuting attorney pensions to the  
3 charge of the pension management oversight commission:  
4           (1) Whether a prosecuting attorney who has contributed to the  
5 prosecuting attorneys retirement fund for a prescribed number of  
6 years may be allowed to cease contributing to the fund.  
7           (2) The feasibility of reducing the number of years required to vest  
8 in the prosecuting attorneys retirement fund from ten (10) to eight  
9 (8) years.  
10          (3) The feasibility of basing the calculation of retirement and  
11 disability benefits for a prosecuting attorneys retirement fund  
12 member on the current salary of the office from which the member  
13 retired instead of the salary at the time the member left office.  
14          (4) The feasibility of increasing the percentages used to compute  
15 retirement and disability benefits under the prosecuting attorneys  
16 retirement fund.



- 1 (5) The feasibility of prorating benefits for partial years of service.
- 2 (6) The feasibility of changing the reduction factor for retirement
- 3 before sixty-five (65) years of age.
- 4 (7) The feasibility of eliminating the requirement that a member
- 5 must have at least five (5) years of service to be eligible to receive
- 6 disability benefits.
- 7 (8) Any other topic related to the prosecuting attorneys retirement
- 8 fund that the commission considers necessary.
