A HOUSE RESOLUTION to recognize Penn's Henry Wilk for being honored by the Indiana Wrestling Hall of Fame as a wrestler and soon to be honored on February 21, 1999 as a coach..

Whereas, Henry Wilk was a state champion wrestler while attending Mishawaka High School. Wilk was previously honored by the Indiana Wrestling Hall of Fame for his student-athlete accomplishments;

Whereas, Henry Wilk has coached high school wrestling for 23 years, the last 12 years at Penn High School, where he has been a three-time state finalist as a coach; and

Whereas, Henry Wilk has been selected this year, as one of four coaches to enter the Hall of Fame by the Indiana High School Wrestling Coaches Association.
