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A HOUSE RESOLUTION to create a committee to study the Bureau of Motor Vehicles and the Bureau of Motor Vehicles Commission.

*Whereas, The Bureau of Motor Vehicles and the Bureau of Motor Vehicles Commission have not been the subject of a recent legislative study;*

*Whereas, A great deal of public interest has developed on the subject; and*

*Whereas, A study committee should determine the annual cost of operating the license branches, determine service charges needed to fund the branches, and research and hear testimony on ways to reduce costs for the branches through*

*contracts with private contractors or new technology as*



*available; Now, therefore,*

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the  
General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

SECTION 1. The Legislative Council is urged to establish a study committee to determine the annual cost of operating the license branches, determine service charges needed to fund the branches, and research and hear testimony on ways to reduce costs for the branches through contracts with private contractors or new technology as available.

SECTION 2. That the study committee, if created, shall consist of six (6) members appointed as follows:

(1) Two (2) members of the senate, not more than one (1) of whom may be affiliated with the same political party, to be appointed by the president pro tempore of the senate.

(2) Two (2) members of the house of representatives, not more than one (1) of whom may be affiliated with the same political party, to be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

(3) Two (2) individuals who are not members of the general assembly, not more than one (1) of whom may be affiliated with the same political party, to be appointed by the legislative council.

SECTION 3. That the study committee, if created, shall be created under the direction of the Legislative Council.
