*Whereas, On November 9, 1998, the Franklin Central Boys Cross-Country Team became the state champions at a meet held on the Indiana University golf course in Bloomington, Indiana;*

*Whereas, The Franklin Central Cross-Country team consists of Aaron Fisher, Nate Dingers, Charlie Dolk, Brent Doughty, Brian Dunn, Brian Janes, Sam Marlin, Justin Nolan, Mark Rode, Chris Sachse, Brandon Shipp, Matt Sweetman, Head Coach Eric Kellison, and Assistant Coaches Anthony Hibbs and Jack Spence;*

*Whereas, This win marks a historic event in Franklin Central's history since this was the first state cross-country competition that the team had participated in;*

*Whereas, Team member Aaron Fisher won the Individual Championship with a record time of 15:30 for the 5K (3.2 miles) run;*

*Whereas, In addition to the state championship, the Franklin Central team won the Warren Central Hokum Karem Invitational, the Martinsville Invitational, the Cathedral Invitational, the Franklin Central Invitational, and Conference Indiana;*
