HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION condemning terrorist acts.

Whereas, An Indianapolis health care clinic, a parochial school, and a bank were targeted by threats of anthrax exposure in 1998;

Whereas, The fear and intimidation that the citizens of Indiana are forced to endure in these types of situations is deplorable because every citizen of the state of Indiana has the right to feel secure in the pursuit of his or her other daily activities;

Whereas, Extreme public measures costing tens of thousands of dollars are required to be expended in properly handling these threats of violence, whether they be by anthrax exposure or some other means; and

Whereas, The terrorists who perpetrated these acts of violence have demonstrated the vulnerability of our public and private institutions to massive threats of violence and the disruption of normal society in dealing with such threats: Therefore,

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives
of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,
the Senate concurring:*

1 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly takes this
2 opportunity to condemn any and all terrorist acts and threats of



1 violence to persons and property of any Indiana public or private
2 institution or any other facility where Indiana citizens go for
3 employment or services.

4 SECTION 2. That the Indiana General Assembly emphasizes the
5 need for complete and tenacious investigations and absolute
6 prosecution of such acts by all law enforcement and judicial agencies.
