A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION congratulating the Martinsville Girls' Golf Team on winning its fourth consecutive state championship.

*Whereas, On Monday, October 5, 1998, at Avon's Prestwick Country Club, the Martinsville Girls' Golf Team won its fourth consecutive state championship and the seventh in the last eight years;*

*Whereas, The team set or tied several records, including a second round low team score of 308 and tied the two-day record score of 142 set in 1996;*

*Whereas, Junior Leigh Anne Hardin became the fourth player to ever win two individual state championships and Senior co-captains Erin Roe and Heather Rose became the first players in state history to play on four state championship golf teams;*

*Whereas, Leigh Anne Hardin, Erin Roe, and Heather Rose were named to the All-State team for their efforts throughout the state tournament;*

*Whereas, All five Arties were listed in the individual Top 20 with Leigh Ann Hardin finishing 1st; Heather Rose, 8th; Erin Roe, 15th; Bethany Bruuner, 17th; and Ashlie Rose, 18th;*

*Whereas, The Martinsville Girls Golf Team members have forged a place for themselves in history as a result of their accomplishments; and*



*Whereas, Special recognition is due to people who achieve extraordinary goals whether they be on the athletic field, the classroom, or in everyday life: Therefore,*
