A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION congratulating Tecumseh High School, Lynnville, Indiana, on winning the IHSAA Class A Boys State Basketball Championship.

Whereas, Tecumseh High School, Lynnville, Indiana, became the IHSAA Class A Boys State Basketball Champions on Saturday, March 27, 1999, in the RCA Dome when they defeated defending state champions Lafayette Central Catholic 55 - 43;

Whereas, The Tecumseh High School Braves, with an enrollment of 299, enjoyed their best season ever in 1999, finishing with a 23 - 4 record and winning their first sectional, regional, semistate, and state championships;

Whereas, This state championship was the first in any sport for the Tecumseh Braves;

Whereas, Tecumseh reached the state championship by defeating Milan High School (57 - 53) in the semifinals and defending semistate champions Bloomfield High School (46-44);

Whereas, Jake Holder, a 6'3" forward, was selected by the IHSAA Executive Committee to receive the Arthur L. Trester Award for Class A Boys Basketball;

Whereas, Jake Holder, who plans to pursue a career in elementary education at Franklin College next year, contributed 15 points in the final game;



Whereas, In addition to Jake Holder, Tecumseh had three other players who scored in double figures - Jimmy Funkhouser, Jeremy Broshears, and Matt Potter;

Whereas, The Tecumseh Braves outscored their opponent in three of the four quarters in the championship game;

Whereas, Coach Oxley credits the team's success this season to mental toughness and desire; and

Whereas, Excellence such as this deserves special recognition: Therefore,
