A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring Purdue University quarterback Drew Brees.

Whereas, Quarterback Drew Brees is considered to be a heady player and a mature leader who has a strong arm;

Whereas, Drew Brees holds many Big Ten, NCAA, and Purdue records, including 569 passing attempts in a season (1998), 361 passing completions in a season (1998), 3,983 passing yards in a season (1998), 39 touchdown passes in a season (1998), and 4,176 total yards in a season (1998);

Whereas, Drew Brees, who hails from Austin, Texas, is a management major at Purdue University;

Whereas, In high school, Drew Brees was the 5A Most Valuable Offensive Player and led his team to a 16 - 0 record and the state championship; and
