Whereas, Mrs. Mahoney was a graduate of Thornton Fractional High School in Calumet City, Illinois, and attended Kansas State Teachers College;

Whereas, While Donnabelle Mahoney was totally dedicated to her family, she still found time and energy to serve her state loyally and well for a number of years, serving as a legislator, personnel director for the city of Hammond, and a member of the League of Women Voters; and

Whereas, Donnabelle Mahoney will be missed by many: by her family, countless friends, the people of Schererville, and Hoosiers everywhere - they loved and respected her and she enriched their lives: Therefore,
