A HOUSE RESOLUTION to recognize Jacqueline Greenwood for being honored in the 1st annual "John Stanford Education Heroes" award ceremony in Washington D. C. on Capitol Hill on December 9, 1998.

Whereas, Jacqueline Greenwood in 1987 became the first female high school principal in the history of the Indianapolis Public School system, a position she continues to serve at Arlington High School;

Whereas, Jacqueline has spent her years at Arlington High School transforming it from a school plagued with violence and gangs to an upstanding learning facility;

Whereas, Jacqueline formed the "Security Dads" program



to chaperone all school sponsored social and athletic events, which in turn promotes positive role models and reduce risk of violence;

Whereas, for the students she also came up with "The Knights of the Round table" that was implemented to transform youth gang members into positive student leaders, focusing on academic achievement and extra-curricular activities;

Whereas, due to Jacqueline Greenwood's tireless efforts to transform Arlington High School, *Redbook Magazine* recognized the school as one of the nation's best schools for community and parental involvement;

Whereas, Jacqueline is not only an asset to her high school, but also to the community of Indianapolis. In between all her responsibilities as a principal she still finds the time to remain active in the community by serving on the Mayor's Task Force, the Community Council, the IMPACT Advisory Council of Goodwill Industries, and a Sunday school teacher at Crooked Creek Baptist Church;

Whereas, Jacqueline Greenwood is a woman committed to improving her school as well as her community, which has definitely been displayed by her involvement continuously;
