A HOUSE RESOLUTION to honor the life of Stanley Przybylinski for his countless contributions to Michigan City and the State of Indiana.

Whereas, Stanley Przybylinski lived a wonderful eighty-two years and along his journey made a strong impact to many;

Whereas, Stanley Przybylinski was born August 2, 1916, in Michigan City to Stanley J. and Hattie Tefelski Przybylinski Sr.. He was 100 percent Polish and was very proud to pass on his heritage to his future family;

Whereas, Mr. Przybylinski was known to many as a dedicated and determined individual who was always hard working. To many he was often referred to by the name "Stack", which developed from his high school boxing days. Mr. Przybylinski won the heavy-weight title at 175 pounds and



received a new suit for his prize. Boxing was the only way Mr. Przybylinski had of getting a suit to wear to his high school graduation;

Whereas, Stanley Przybylinski served as a soldier in the U.S. Army during World War II;

Whereas, Stanley Przybylinski served twenty-eight years on the City Council, beginning in 1960 and ending in 1992, with a four-year hiatus between 1964 and 1968. He served 16 years on the Port Authority, beginning in 1961 when the authority was established;

Whereas, Stanley Przybylinski was very active in many organizations such as: member of St. Stanislaus Catholic Church; a founder and charter member of American Legion Skiwat Post 451. He was also a loan officer for First Citizens Bank for 15 years during his city councilman years and had worked at Pullman-Standard as a machinist;and

Whereas, Stanley Przybylinski was a man who contributed significantly to his city and family. His wife Alice M. Kregger, whom he married on June 28, 1947 and who passed away on May 19, 1983, have left behind four sons, all of Michigan City; three daughters; and 12 grandchildren.
