A HOUSE RESOLUTION to support Serenity House, Inc. for their dedication to aiding in alcoholic recovery and drug addiction.

Whereas, April 1978 Serenity Club officially opened at 3401 West 25th Avenue to serve the addiction problem of Gary and Lake County;

Whereas, Serenity Club has served Gary, Indiana and the State of Indiana for 21 years;

Whereas, innumerable families and persons with a need for information, meetings, counseling, housing, food, employment assistance and clothing has been served;

Whereas, in 1980 Serenity Club opened Serenity House to serve male addicted clients at 439 Marshall;



Whereas, in 1989 Serenity House relocated from 439 to 5157 Harrison, from a 50 x 175 ft. lot to 9.2 acres;

Whereas, Serenity House expanded it's services from males to males and females to be able to serve over 20 persons at a time;

Whereas, Serenity Club moved from 3401 West 25th Avenue to 3825 Broadway and expanded community services from 8 support group meetings to now 18 support group meetings along with spiritual concerts, community seminars, health alerts, HIV testing and information;

Whereas, Serenity House is nationally accredited and a recognized leader in the addiction field;

Whereas, Serenity House and Mozell Haymon have received many awards for distinguish service to addicted persons and the general community;

Whereas, Serenity House will celebrate 21 years of continued untiring service with a banquet on April 24, 1999;

Whereas, Norma Jean Carter of Riverside, California will be the guest speaker and deliver an exciting, enlightning message to attendee's;

Whereas, Mrs. Carter has spoken in over 48 states;

Whereas, Serenity House will hopefully expand services to solve housing, women with children issues and full employment training programs for participants.
