A HOUSE RESOLUTION Honoring Colonel Scott Minier of the Marion County Sheriff's Department for Earning the Mac Gray Award for Excellence in Public Service Advertising.

Whereas, Scott Minier received the Mac Gray Award for ten years of outstanding volunteer work on the National Citizens' Crime Prevention Council, the U.S. Department of Justice and the Ad Council;

Whereas, The Mac Gray Award memorializes Berleley McCabe "Mac" Gray II, late director of the National Crime Prevention Council, and his stewardship in developing the highly successful McGruff the Crime Dog and his nephew Scruff public service campaigns;

Whereas, Scott Minier has been developing creative ideas for effective public service announcements since 1988;



Whereas, Scott Minier created what is now known as the Indiana Crime Prevention Coalition in 1990, and under Scott's direction, the Coalition become the nation's largest grassroots organization of its kind;

Whereas, Scott Minier developed the idea of localizing public service announcements to maximize the effectiveness of those announcements;

Whereas, The creative ideas of Scott Minier have resulted in 12,000 members participating in the Indiana Crime Prevention Coalition, and more than two million dollars being raised for crime Prevention activities across Indiana;

Whereas, Scott Minier is administrative assistant to Marion County Sheriff Jack Cottey in addition to his responsibilities as executive director of the not-for-profit Indiana Crime Prevention Coalition; and

Whereas, The dedication of Scott Minier to educating the public about crime prevention has been a tremendous benefit to the citizens of his community, and this state; *Now, therefore,*

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the
General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly honors Scott Minier dedicating his life to crime prevention and earning the Mac Gray Award for Excellence in Public Service Advertising.
