*Whereas, The incidents of violence in our schools are increasing;*

*Whereas, This violence far too often results in death and injury to our children while in school or on the way to school; and*

*Whereas, This violence is most often the result of children in possession of firearms or deadly weapons: Therefore,*

*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the  
General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to establish an interim study committee on violence in schools.

SECTION 2. That the study committee, if established, should study the following:

(1) The expulsion for one year of a child found to be in possession of the firearm while on school property or on a school bus.

(2) The requirement of a school employee to notify in writing the school superintendent if a student is in possession of a firearm while on school property or on a school bus.

(3) The requirement of a school superintendent who receives such written notification to notify a law enforcement agency.

(4) The requirement of a child found to be in possession of a firearm to be held in detention and the parents immediately notified.

(5) The psychological evaluation of a child found to be in possession of a firearm on school property or on a school bus.

(6) The placement in detention of a child found to be in possession of a firearm on school property or on a school bus.

SECTION 3. That the committee, if established, shall operate under the direction of the legislative council and that the committee shall issue a final report by December 1, 1999.
