## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 9-16-1-5.5.

**Synopsis:** Requires public restrooms in license branches. Provides that a full service license branch must have at least one handicap-accessible restroom available for use of the public. Provides that a full service license branch that leases space is not required to provide at least one restroom for the use of the public until the lease for the full service license branch is renewed or a new lease is entered into after June 30, 1999.

**Effective:** July 1, 1999.

## SENATE BILL No. 30

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-16-1-5.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 1999]: **Sec. 5.5. Each full service license branch must provide at  
4 least one (1) restroom available for the public that complies with  
5 the building rules required by IC 22-13-4-1.5.**

6 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999] (a) **Notwithstanding  
7 IC 9-16-1-5.5, as added by this act, a full service license branch that  
8 operates in a leased space as of June 30, 1999, is not required to  
9 provide at least one (1) restroom for use of the public until the  
10 lease for the full service license branch is renewed or a new lease  
11 is entered into after June 30, 1999.**

12 (b) **This SECTION expires March 31, 2004.**
