## SENATE BILL No. 76

---

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-41-25-1 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 1. The state  
3 department shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 that provide for a  
4 reasonable period not exceeding forty-five (45) days in which a plan  
5 review and permit for residential septic systems must be approved or  
6 disapproved. **However, a rule that the state department adopts  
7 concerning residential septic systems may not prohibit the  
8 installation of a residential septic system on a plat if:**

9 (1) the installation of a residential septic system on the plat  
10 was approved by a local health department; and  
11 (2) the plat of the affected lot was recorded;  
12 **before the effective date of the rule.**

13 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
