SENATE BILL No. 271

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning commerce and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999] (a) **There is**
2 **appropriated to the department of commerce to be credited to the**
3 **rural development fund (IC 4-4-9-2) one million dollars**
4 **(\$1,000,000) from the state general fund for each state fiscal year**
5 **of the biennium beginning July 1, 1999. The department shall use**
6 **the money as provided by IC 4-4-9. However, the department shall**
7 **use one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) each state fiscal year**
8 **as an appropriation for total operating expenses for the rural**
9 **development council and nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000)**
10 **shall be used each state fiscal year to make grants for regional**
11 **development projects.**

12 (b) **This SECTION expires June 30, 2001.**
