

SENATE BILL No. 347

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-5-2-8.

Synopsis: Tie votes on town boards. Specifies that the town clerk-treasurer is an ex officio member of the town legislative body for the purpose of casting the deciding vote to break a tie, regardless of whether the town legislative body consists of an even or odd number of members.

Effective: July 1, 1999.
