

SENATE BILL No. 404

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-15-5-1; IC 12-15-13-7.

Synopsis: Advanced practice nurse services. Adds services provided by advanced practice nurses to the services that are provided under Medicaid, so long as those services are rendered in a school based clinic, community health center, or federally qualified health center. Provides that an advanced practice nurse is eligible for direct reimbursement from Medicaid for providing services in a school based clinic, community health center, or federally qualified health center.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 1. Except as provided

4 and supplies are provided under Medicaid:
5 (1) Inpatient hospital services.
6 (2) Nursing facility services.
7 (3) Physician's services, including services provided under
8 IC 25-10-1 and IC 25-22.5-1.
9 (4) Outpatient hospital or clinic services.
10 (5) Home health care services.
11 (6) Private duty nursing services.
12 (7) Physical therapy and related services.
13 (8) Dental services.
14 (9) Prescribed laboratory and x-ray services.
15 (10) Prescribed drugs and services.
16 (11) Eyeglasses and prosthetic devices.
17 (12) Optometric services.



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- 1 (13) Diagnostic, screening, preventive, and rehabilitative services.
 2 (14) Podiatric medicine services.
 3 (15) Hospice services.
 4 (16) Services or supplies recognized under Indiana law and
 5 specified under rules adopted by the office.
 6 (17) Family planning services except the performance of
 7 abortions.
 8 (18) Nonmedical nursing care given in accordance with the tenets

 24 SECTION 2. IC 12-15-13-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 25 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 26 1, 1999]: **Sec. 7. The office shall reimburse an advanced practice**
 27 **nurse (as defined in IC 25-23-1-1(b)) for services provided by the**
 28 **advanced practice nurse in any of the following settings:**
 29 (1) School based clinics.
 30 (2) Community health centers.
 31 (3) Federally qualified health centers (as defined in 42 U.S.C.
 32 1396d(1)(2)(B)).

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
