DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-5-7-12; IC 7.1-5-7-13.

Synopsis: Minors ringing up alcohol sales. Prohibits a minor from ringing up a sale of alcoholic beverages. (Under alcoholic beverage laws, a minor is a person less than 21 years of age.)

Effective: July 1, 1999.

SENATE BILL No. 416



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcoholic beverages.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-5-7-12 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 12. **Employment of**
3 ~~Minors Prohibited~~. It is a Class B misdemeanor for a person to employ
4 a minor in or about a place where alcoholic beverages are sold,
5 furnished, or given away for consumption either on or off the licensed
6 premises, in a capacity which requires or allows the minor to sell, **ring**
7 **up a sale**, furnish, or otherwise deal in alcoholic beverages.

8 SECTION 2. IC 7.1-5-7-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
9 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 13. **Employment of**
10 **Minors: Exceptions**. ~~The provisions of IC 1971, 7.1-5-7-12, shall~~
11 **Section 12 of this chapter does** not prohibit the employment of a
12 person eighteen (18) years of age or older on or about licensed
13 premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, furnished, or given away
14 for consumption either on or off the licensed premises, **if the person's**
15 **employment is** for a purpose other than selling, **ringing up a sale**,
16 furnishing, consuming or otherwise dealing in alcoholic beverages. ~~Nor~~
17 ~~shall the provisions of IC 1971, 7.1-5-7-12, prohibit a person eighteen~~
