

SENATE BILL No. 551

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 13-11-2-164.

Synopsis: Drinking water and wastewater loans. Allows any entity that is eligible to receive funds under the federal law concerning state water pollution control revolving loan funds to receive financial assistance from the wastewater revolving loan fund and the supplemental wastewater assistance fund. Allows any entity that is eligible to receive funds under the federal law concerning state drinking water treatment revolving loan funds to receive financial assistance from the drinking water revolving loan fund and the supplemental drinking water assistance fund.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
