## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 25-6.1-9-9.

**Synopsis:** Auctioneer continuing education requirements. Removes provision prohibiting an individual from performing an act that requires an auctioneer license when the individual has been granted a waiver from the continuing education requirement for license renewal.

**Effective:** July 1, 1999.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1014

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 25-6.1-9-9 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 9. (a) The commission  
3 may grant an applicant a waiver from all or part of the continuing  
4 education requirement for the renewal period if the applicant was not  
5 able to fulfill the requirement due to a hardship that resulted from any  
6 of the following conditions:  
7 (1) Service in the armed forces of the United States during a  
8 substantial part of the renewal period.  
9 (2) An incapacitating illness or injury.  
10 (3) Other circumstances determined by the commission.  
11 (b) An individual granted a waiver under subsection (a) may not  
12 perform an act that requires an auctioneer license until the individual  
13 has fulfilled the continuing education requirement under section † of  
14 this chapter.
