DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Indiana institute on recycling. Extends the Indiana institute on recycling to June 30, 2001. (Under current law, the institute will terminate June 30, 1999.)

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 13-20-18-11 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 11. The institute
3 terminates June 30, ~~1999~~. **2001**.

4 SECTION 2. IC 13-20-18-12 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
5 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 12. This chapter
6 expires June 30, ~~1999~~. **2001**.

7 SECTION 3. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
