DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 21-3-1.7-9.8.

Synopsis: Academic honors diploma award. Requires an individual to be enrolled in a program of postsecondary education in order to be eligible to receive money from a school corporation for earning an academic honors diploma.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1349

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education finance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 21-3-1.7-9.8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 9.8. (a) In addition to
3 the distributions under sections 8, 9.5, and 9.7 of this chapter, a school
4 corporation is eligible for an **academic** honors diploma award in the
5 amount determined under STEP TWO of the following formula:
6 STEP ONE: Determine the number of the school corporation's
7 eligible pupils who successfully completed an academic honors
8 diploma program in the school year ending in the previous
9 calendar year.
10 STEP TWO: Multiply the STEP ONE amount by eight hundred
11 dollars (\$800).
12 (b) Each year the governing body of a school corporation may use
13 the money that the school corporation receives for an **academic** honors
14 diploma award under this section to give eight hundred dollars (\$800)
15 to each eligible pupil in the school corporation who:
16 (1) successfully completes an academic honors diploma program
17 in the school year ending in the previous calendar year; **and**
