

# HOUSE BILL No. 1377

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 36-8-16-13.

**Synopsis:** Enhanced emergency telephone system fees. Requires a county to distribute the balance of the county's emergency telephone system fund to each unit in the county in an amount proportional to the amount of the fund contributed to the fund by service users in the unit. Provides that the distributions are made quarterly. Requires that the funds distributed may only be used for purposes allowed for the county emergency telephone system fund.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1377



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-8-16-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 13. **(a)** A county  
 3 treasurer or municipal fiscal officer to whom enhanced emergency  
 4 telephone system fees are remitted under section 12 of this chapter  
 5 shall deposit the fees in a separate fund. The fund shall be known as the  
 6 \_\_\_\_\_ (insert name of county or municipality) emergency  
 7 telephone system fund. The county treasurer or municipal fiscal officer  
 8 may invest money in the fund in the same manner that other money of  
 9 the county or municipality may be invested. The county treasurer or  
 10 municipal fiscal officer shall deposit any income earned from such an  
 11 investment in the fund.

12 **(b) If a county fiscal body has adopted an ordinance under**  
 13 **section 5 of this chapter to impose a monthly enhanced emergency**  
 14 **telephone system fee for each exchange access facility used in the**  
 15 **county, at the end of each quarter in a calendar year the county**  
 16 **auditor shall distribute from the emergency telephone system fund**  
 17 **to each unit within the county the part of the balance of the fund**



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1       **that is proportional to the amount contributed to the fund by**  
2       **service users in the unit. The county auditor shall make the**  
3       **distribution on the last business day of each quarter of the calendar**  
4       **year. The unit may only use the funds distributed from the**  
5       **emergency telephone system fund for the purposes specified in**  
6       **section 14 of this chapter.**

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
