

# HOUSE BILL No. 1392

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 7.1-1-2-13.

**Synopsis:** Salary matrix for excise police officers. Provides that the salary matrix for excise police officers must have parity with the salary matrices prescribed for conservation officers of the department of natural resources.

**Effective:** July 1, 1999.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1392

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcoholic beverages.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-1-2-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 13. (a) The alcoholic  
3 beverage commission shall categorize salaries of enforcement officers  
4 within each rank based upon the rank held and the number of years of  
5 service in the commission through the tenth year. The salary ranges  
6 that the board assigns to each rank shall be divided into a base salary  
7 and ten (10) increments above the base salary with:  
8 (1) the base salary in the rank paid to a person with less than one  
9 (1) year of service in the commission; and  
10 (2) the highest salary in the rank paid to a person with at least ten  
11 (10) years of service in the commission.  
12 (b) For purposes of creating the salary matrix prescribed by this  
13 section, the alcoholic beverage commission may not approve salary  
14 ranges for any rank that are less than the salary ranges effective for that  
15 rank on January 1, 1995.  
16 (c) The salary matrix prescribed by this section shall be reviewed  
17 and approved by the budget agency before implementation.

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1 (d) The money needed to fund the salaries resulting from the matrix  
2 prescribed by this section shall come from the amounts appropriated  
3 from the professional and technical equity fund as augmented by the  
4 budget agency from the state general fund.  
5 (e) **The salary matrix prescribed by this section must have**  
6 **parity with the salary matrices prescribed by the natural resources**  
7 **commission under IC 14-9-8 for conservation officers of the**  
8 **department of natural resources. The budget agency shall approve**  
9 **a salary matrix that meets the parity requirement of this**  
10 **subsection.**

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
