DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-2-1-15.2.

Synopsis: Northwest Indiana law enforcement training center. Removes the July 1, 2000, expiration date from a provision that allows the northwest Indiana law enforcement training center to provide basic training to a law enforcement officer who meets certain requirements.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 15.2. ~~(a)~~ The northwest

4 a law enforcement officer who is:
5 (1) employed by a law enforcement agency that is a member
6 agency of the northwest Indiana law enforcement training center;
7 and
8 (2) not accepted by the law enforcement academy for the next
9 basic training course because the academy does not have a space
10 for the officer in the next basic training course.
