**Synopsis:** State advisory council for medical education. Establishes a state advisory council to support medical education. Provides that the state advisory council consists of two representatives from each community advisory council. Provides that each community advisory council selects its own representatives to the state council.

First Regular Session 111th General Assembly (1999)

## HOUSE BILL No. 1438

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-12-30.5-3 IS AMENDED TO READ AS  
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 3. **(a)** A director shall  
3 be jointly appointed for each center in the system by the office of Dean  
4 of the Indiana University School of Medicine and the local cooperating  
5 institution or institutions and hold a joint appointment with the local  
6 cooperating institutions. An advisory council shall also be appointed by  
7 each local center to provide as effectively as possible for a high degree  
8 of support and advice from the lay and professional communities.  
9 **(b) The state advisory council is established to act as a resource**  
10 **to support medical education. The state advisory council consists**  
11 **of two (2) representatives from each community advisory council.**  
12 **Each community advisory council shall select its own**  
13 **representatives.**
