DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Regulated place of amusement or entertainment. Amends the definition of "regulated place of amusement or entertainment" under the fire safety, building, and equipment law.

HOUSE BILL No. 1478

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and industrial safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 22-12-1-23 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 23. "Regulated place
3 of amusement or entertainment" refers to the following:

4 (1) ~~A theater, opera house, movie theater, dance hall, night club~~

11 ~~movies are provided more than twice each calendar week;~~

12 (B) ~~more than ten (10) pool tables, electronic game~~
13 ~~machines, or other games are available for patron use; or~~

14 (C) ~~professional sporting activities are conducted.~~

15 (2) ~~A place where a boxing exhibition is conducted under the~~
16 ~~supervision of the state boxing commission.~~

17 (3) ~~A hall, gymnasium, or place of assembly where a school,~~
