

## HOUSE BILL No. 1486

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### DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** None (noncode).

**Synopsis:** Environmental remediation grant. Provides that the Indiana development finance authority may provide a grant of not more than \$3,000,000 from the environmental remediation revolving loan fund to the city of Gary. Provides that the grant may be used for purposes authorized under the environmental remediation revolving loan program.

**Effective:** July 1, 1999.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning environmental law.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999] (a) **Notwithstanding**  
2 **any provision of IC 13-19-5, the Indiana development finance**  
3 **authority may provide a grant of not more than three million**  
4 **dollars (\$3,000,000) from the environmental remediation revolving**  
5 **loan fund to a city having a population of more than one hundred**  
6 **ten thousand (110,000) but less than one hundred twenty thousand**  
7 **(120,000). The city may use the grant to conduct any activity**  
8 **authorized by IC 13-19-5.**  
9 (b) **Before the Indiana development finance authority may**  
10 **provide a grant to a city under this SECTION, the city must:**  
11 (1) **submit to the authority any information required by the**  
12 **authority concerning the proposed uses of the grant; and**  
13 (2) **enter into a financial assistance agreement with the**  
14 **authority under IC 13-19-5.**  
15 (c) **This SECTION expires January 1, 2003.**



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
