

HOUSE BILL No. 1600

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-7-31.3-8.

Synopsis: Economic development. Provides that in Fort Wayne, a professional sports and convention development area may include a facility connected to and shares at least one common area with a facility that is included in the development area and used for convention and tourism related events.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1600

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-7-31.3-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 8. A city or county
3 legislative body may establish as part of a professional sports and
4 convention development area any facility that is:

5 (1) owned by the city, the county, a school corporation, or a board
6 under IC 36-10-8, IC 36-10-10, or IC 36-10-11 and used by a
7 professional sports franchise; ~~or~~

8 (2) owned by the city, the county, or a board under IC 36-10-8,
9 IC 36-10-10, or IC 36-10-11 and used for convention or tourism
10 related events; ~~or~~

11 **(3) located in a city having a population of more than one**
12 **hundred fifty thousand (150,000) but less than five hundred**
13 **thousand (500,000) and is connected to and shares at least one**
14 **(1) common area with unobstructed ingress and egress to a**
15 **facility described in subdivision (2).**

16 The tax area may include only facilities described in this section and
17 any parcel of land on which the facility is located. An area may contain

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1 noncontiguous tracts of land within the city or county.

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
