

HOUSE BILL No. 1604

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 14-16-2.

Synopsis: Snowmobile registration fees. Increases the fee from \$15 to \$30 for the registration of a snowmobile with the department of natural resources. Provides that the department of natural resources may purchase land for snowmobile trails only from a willing seller of the land. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the natural resources study committee.)

Effective: July 1, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1604

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning natural and cultural resources.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 14-16-2-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 7. (a) The owner of
- 3 each snowmobile required to be registered under this chapter must do
- 4 the following:
- 5 (1) File an application for registration with the department on
- 6 forms provided by the department.
- 7 (2) Sign the application.
- 8 (3) Pay a fee of ~~fifteen dollars (\$15)~~; **thirty dollars (\$30)**.
- 9 (b) Upon receipt of an application in approved form, the department
- 10 shall enter the application upon the department's records and issue to
- 11 the applicant the following:
- 12 (1) A certificate of registration containing the following:
- 13 (A) The number awarded to the snowmobile.
- 14 (B) The name and address of the owner.
- 15 (C) Other information that the department considers necessary.
- 16 (2) Two (2) decals indicating the year of expiration that shall be
- 17 attached to the snowmobile as provided in section 12 of this

 2 (c) A certificate of registration must:
 3 (1) be pocket size;
 4 (2) accompany the snowmobile; and
 5 (3) be made available for inspection upon demand by a law
 6 enforcement officer.
 7 (d) A person may not alter in any manner a certificate of registration
 8 issued by the department.
 9 SECTION 2. IC 14-16-2-27 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
 10 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 27. (a) The department
 11 shall do the following:
 12 (1) Prescribe the form of accident reports and registration
 13 certificates and the form of application for the certificates.
 14 (2) Conduct a campaign of education with respect to safety in the
 15 operation of snowmobiles in connection with the use and
 16 enjoyment of the public and private land of Indiana and with
 17 respect to Indiana laws relating to snowmobiles.
 18 (3) Construct and maintain snowmobile trails on public and
 19 private land consistent with the intent of this chapter.
 20 (b) **Notwithstanding any other law, the department may**
 21 **purchase land for snowmobile trails only from a willing seller of**
 22 **the land.**
