

HOUSE BILL No. 1606

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-1-7-6.

Synopsis: Local government agreements. Extends by 30 days the deadline before which a local unit of government must file copies of interlocal agreements with the state board of accounts. (Current law requires an agreement to be filed within 60 days after the agreement takes effect.)

Effective: July 1, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1606

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-1-7-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
2 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 6. Before it takes effect, an
3 agreement under section 3 of this chapter must be recorded with the
4 county recorder. Not later than ~~sixty (60)~~ **ninety (90)** days after it takes
5 effect, such an agreement must be filed with the state board of accounts
6 for audit purposes.
