Synopsis: Harrison township fire department. Appropriates \$237,000 from the state general fund to the Harrison township (Howard County) volunteer fire department to construct an addition to the fire station (a portion of which will be used as an office for the township trustee).

HOUSE BILL No. 1617

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning state and local administration and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999] (a) **There is**
2 **appropriated to the Harrison township (Howard County) volunteer**
3 **fire department two hundred thirty-seven thousand dollars**
4 **(\$237,000) from the state general fund for an addition to the fire**
5 **station (a portion of which will be used by the township trustee) for**
6 **the period beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.**
7 (b) **The amounts appropriated under this SECTION are in**
8 **addition to any amounts appropriated under any other act.**
9 (c) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2001.**
