

HOUSE BILL No. 1671

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-19-3-27.

Synopsis: Family planning services. Requires the state department of health to apply for federal family planning grants. Requires the state department of health to implement a program to award grants to public or nonprofit private entities that provide family planning services to women in households with income that is not more than 250% of the federal poverty level. Appropriates \$2 million a year for these grants through June 30, 2004.

Effective: Upon passage; July 1, 1999.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 16-19-3-27 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
- 2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
- 3 1, 1999]: **Sec. 27. The state department shall apply to the United**
- 4 **States Department of Health and Human Services for family**
- 5 **planning grants awarded under Title X of the Public Health**
- 6 **Service Act of 1970 (42 U.S.C. 300 et seq.).**
- 7 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **The state**
- 8 **department of health shall implement a program to award grants**
- 9 **to public or nonprofit private entities that provide family planning**
- 10 **services to women who live in households with income that is not**
- 11 **more than two hundred fifty percent (250%) of the federal poverty**
- 12 **level.**
- 13 (b) **There is annually appropriated to the state department of**
- 14 **health two million dollars (\$2,000,000) from the state general fund**
- 15 **to implement the program required under this SECTION.**
- 16 (c) **The state department of health may adopt rules under**
- 17 **IC 4-22-2 to implement this SECTION.**



1 **(d) This SECTION expires June 30, 2004.**
2 **SECTION 3. An emergency is declared for this act.**

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
