
HOUSE BILL No. 1712

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 13-18-3-6.

Synopsis: Enforcement actions against property owner. Limits enforcement actions under an administrative rule governing storm water runoff associated with construction activity to actions against the owner of the property. Requires the water pollution control board to amend that administrative rule not later than February 1, 2000.

Effective: Upon passage.

HOUSE BILL No. 1712

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 13-18-3-6 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 6. (a) The water
3 pollution control laws may be enforced under IC 13-30-3 or
4 IC 13-14-2-6.
5 (b) **Enforcement of any part of 327 IAC 15-5 shall be limited to**
6 **an enforcement action against the owner of the parcel of property.**
7 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **Before**
8 **February 1, 2000, the water pollution control board shall amend**
9 **327 IAC 15-5 to reflect IC 13-18-3-6, as amended by this act.**
10 (b) **This SECTION expires February 1, 2000.**
11 SECTION 3. **An emergency is declared for this act.**



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
