

HOUSE BILL No. 1771

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: None (noncode).

Synopsis: University contracting practices. Requires state educational institutions to analyze their purchasing, construction, and contracting practices relating to minority business enterprises and women's business enterprises. Requires each state educational institution to file a written report of the analysis with the legislative council.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1771

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999] (a) **As used in this**
2 **SECTION, "historically underutilized business enterprise" refers**
3 **to either of the following:**

4 (1) **A minority business enterprise.**

5 (2) **A women's business enterprise.**

6 (b) **As used in this SECTION, "minority business enterprise"**
7 **has the meaning set forth in IC 4-13-16.5-1.**

8 (c) **As used in this SECTION, "reporting period" refers to the**
9 **period:**

10 (1) **beginning January 1, 1997; and**

11 (2) **ending December 31, 1999.**

12 (d) **As used in this SECTION, "state educational institution" has**
13 **the meaning set forth in IC 20-12-0.5-1.**

14 (e) **As used in this SECTION, "women's business enterprise"**
15 **has the meaning set forth in IC 4-33-14-4.**

16 (f) **Each state educational institution shall analyze the state**
17 **educational institution's use of historically underutilized business**
18 **enterprises in the state educational institution's purchasing,**



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construction, and contracting practices.

(g) The analysis required by subsection (f) must include the following information for each historically underutilized business enterprise type described in subsection (a) for each calendar year in the reporting period:

(1) Number of contracts awarded.

(2) Total dollar amount of contracts awarded.

(3) A classification of different contract types awarded by the state educational institution and the number of contracts awarded in each classification.

(4) A description of efforts made by the state educational institution to encourage each historically underutilized business enterprise type to do business with the state educational institution during the reporting period.

(h) The analysis required by subsection (f) must include the same information required for the reporting period by subsection (g) for businesses that are not historically underutilized business enterprises.

(i) Each state educational institution shall file a written report of the results of the analysis required by this SECTION with the legislative council and the governor before November 1, 2000.

(j) This SECTION expires January 1, 2001.

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
