

HOUSE BILL No. 1784

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18-45.

Synopsis: Indiana child protection trust license plate. Requires the bureau to issue an Indiana child protection trust license plate. Requires the additional fee required for the Indiana child protection trust license plate to be deposited in the Indiana child protection trust fund and distributed to an organization established to raise funds for various charitable organizations.

Effective: January 1, 2000.

HOUSE BILL No. 1784

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-18-45 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JANUARY 1, 2000]:

4 **Chapter 45. Indiana Child Protection Trust License Plates**

5 **Sec. 1. The bureau of motor vehicles shall design and issue an**
6 **Indiana child protection trust license plate. The Indiana child**
7 **protection trust license plate shall be designed and issued as a**
8 **special group recognition license plate under IC 9-18-25.**

9 **Sec. 2. After December 31, 1999, a person who is eligible to**
10 **register a vehicle under this title is eligible to receive an Indiana**
11 **child protection trust license plate under this chapter upon doing**
12 **the following:**

13 (1) **Completing an application for an Indiana child protection**
14 **trust license plate.**

15 (2) **Paying the fees under section 3 of this chapter.**

16 **Sec. 3. (a) The fees for an Indiana child protection trust license**

- 1 **(1) The appropriate fee under IC 9-29-5-38(a).**
 2 **(2) An annual fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25).**
 3 **(b) The bureau shall collect the fee described in subsection**
 4 **(a)(2).**
 5 **(c) The annual fee described in subsection (a)(2) shall be**
 6 **deposited in the fund established by section 4 of this chapter.**
 7 **Sec. 4. (a) The Indiana child protection trust fund is established.**
 8 **(b) The treasurer of state shall invest the money in the fund not**
 9 **currently needed to meet the obligations of the fund in the same**
 10 **manner as other public trust funds are invested. Interest that**
 11 **accrues from these investments shall be deposited in the fund.**
 12 **(c) The commissioner shall administer the trust fund. Expenses**
 13 **of administering the fund shall be paid from money in the fund.**
 14 **(d) On June 30 of each year the commissioner shall distribute**
 15 **the money from the fund to the organization established under**
 16 **section 5 of this chapter.**
 17 **(e) Money in the fund at the end of a state fiscal year does not**
 18 **revert to the state general fund.**
 19 **Sec. 5. (a) Representatives of charitable organizations located**
 20 **within Indiana, registered under section 501(c) of the Internal**
 21 **Revenue Code, and designated in subsection (b), shall establish an**
 22 **organization that:**
 23 **(1) is a charitable organization under Section 501(c) of the**
 24 **Internal Revenue Code;**
 25 **(2) is registered to do business in Indiana;**
 26 **(3) is located in Indiana; and**
 27 **(4) exists for the purpose of raising funds on behalf of the**
 28 **organizations designated in subsection (b).**
 29 **(b) Representatives establishing an organization under**
 30 **subsection (a) must include representatives from the following**
 31 **organizations:**
 32 **(1) Crisis Pregnancy Centers.**
 33 **(2) Child adoption agencies.**
 34 **(3) Indiana Citizens for Life.**
 35 **(4) Indiana Right to Life.**
 36 **(c) The organization established under subsection (a) shall**
 37 **distribute the money received under section 4 of this chapter to the**
 38 **organizations designated in subsection (b).**
