DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 33-19-7-5.

Synopsis: Public defense fund. Increases the annual distribution to the public defense fund from \$2,400,000 to \$4,200,000.

Effective: June 29, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1803

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 33-19-7-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JUNE 29, 1999]: Sec. 5. (a) On June 30 and
3 on December 31 of each year, the auditor of state shall transfer to the
4 treasurer of state six million seven hundred four thousand two hundred
5 fifty-seven dollars (\$6,704,257) for distribution under subsection (b).
6 (b) On June 30 and on December 31 of each year the treasurer of
7 state shall deposit into:
8 (1) the family violence and victim assistance fund established
9 under IC 12-18-5-2 an amount equal to eleven and
10 eight-hundredths percent (11.08%);
11 (2) the Indiana judges' retirement fund established under
12 IC 33-13-8 an amount equal to twenty-five and twenty-one
13 hundredths percent (25.21%);
14 (3) the law enforcement academy building fund established under
15 IC 5-2-1-13 an amount equal to three and fifty-two hundredths
16 percent (3.52%);
17 (4) the law enforcement training fund established under



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1 IC 5-2-1-13 an amount equal to fourteen and nineteen-hundredths
 2 percent (14.19%);
 3 (5) the violent crime victims compensation fund established under
 4 IC 5-2-6.1-40 an amount equal to sixteen and fifty-hundredths
 5 percent (16.50%);
 6 (6) the motor vehicle highway account an amount equal to
 7 twenty-six and ninety-five hundredths percent (26.95%);
 8 (7) the fish and wildlife fund established by IC 14-22-3-2 an
 9 amount equal to thirty-two hundredths of one percent (0.32%);
 10 and
 11 (8) the Indiana judicial center drug and alcohol programs fund
 12 established under IC 12-23-14-17 for the administration,
 13 certification, and support of alcohol and drug services programs
 14 under IC 12-23-14 an amount equal to two and twenty-three
 15 hundredths percent (2.23%);
 16 of the amount transferred by the auditor of state under subsection (a).
 17 (c) On June 30 and on December 31 of each year the auditor of state
 18 shall transfer to the treasurer of state ~~one two million two one~~
 19 ~~thousand dollars (\$1,200,000)~~ **(\$2,100,000)** for deposit into the public
 20 defense fund established under IC 33-9-14. **If, after making the**
 21 **distributions required under subsections (a) and (b), insufficient**
 22 **funds exist in the state user fee fund to make any part of the**
 23 **distribution required by this section, the auditor of state shall**
 24 **transfer the remaining balance to the public defense fund from the**
 25 **state general fund.**
 26 SECTION 2. [EFFECTIVE JUNE 29, 1999] **The first distribution**
 27 **under IC 33-19-7-5(c), as amended by this act, shall be made on**
 28 **June 30, 1999.**
 29 SECTION 3. **An emergency is declared for this act.**

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
