DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-12-0.5.

Synopsis: Commission for higher education. Permits a member of the commission for higher education to be a public employee if the person is not an employee or board member of a public or private university or college in Indiana. Permits members of the commission to be reimbursed for lodging expenses incurred while on official business.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1821



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 20-12-0.5-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 5. (a) The commission
3 shall consist of fourteen (14) members, citizens of Indiana, appointed
4 by the governor.

5 (b) Each congressional district shall be represented by at least one
6 (1) member who resides in the congressional district. In addition, one
7 (1) member must be a student and one (1) member must be a full-time
8 faculty member of a higher education institution (as defined in
9 IC 20-12-5.5-1) who shall be appointed by the governor under the
10 procedures set forth in this section.

11 (c) Except for the one (1) full-time faculty member appointed under
12 subsection (b), no member while serving a term may be

13 ~~(1) an employee of or serve on the governing board of any state or~~
14 ~~private college or university school corporation, or other~~
15 ~~educational institution in the state of Indiana. or~~

16 ~~(2) in any other capacity, an employee or official of the state of~~
17 ~~Indiana or a political subdivision in Indiana.~~



1 (d) The governor shall appoint the student member and the full-time
2 faculty member of the commission from a list for each appointment
3 that:

4 (1) contains at least three (3) names but not more than five (5)
5 names; and

6 (2) is submitted by a nominating committee established under
7 subsection (e).

8 (e) The chairman of the commission shall appoint ten (10) members
9 of the nominating committee as follows:

10 (1) Five (5) students from state educational institutions, with not
11 more than one (1) student from any one (1) state educational
12 institution.

13 (2) Five (5) full-time faculty members from state educational
14 institutions, with not more than one (1) full-time faculty member
15 from any one (1) educational institution.

16 SECTION 2. IC 20-12-0.5-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
17 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]: Sec. 7. Organization. The
18 commission shall elect from its membership a chairman and
19 vice-chairman, and other necessary officers. Members shall receive per
20 diem, **lodging**, and mileage for attendance at regular or special
21 meetings and shall be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred on
22 other official duties.

23 SECTION 3. IC 20-12-0.5-9 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY
24 1, 1999].
