DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-23-2-7.

Synopsis: Appropriation for the Indiana arts commission. Appropriates \$5,544,159 annually from the state general fund to the Indiana arts commission to provide program and service grants to arts providers.

Effective: July 1, 1999.

HOUSE BILL No. 1824

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-23-2-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 1999]: **Sec. 7. There is annually appropriated to the Indiana arts**
4 **commission five million five hundred forty-four thousand one**
5 **hundred fifty-nine dollars (\$5,544,159) from the state general fund**
6 **to provide program and service grants to arts providers under**
7 **IC 4-23-2.5.**
