

# HOUSE BILL No. 1886

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 12-15-13-7.

**Synopsis:** Federally qualified health centers. Requires the office of Medicaid policy and planning to base reimbursement to a federally qualified health center on the federally qualified health center's reasonable costs.

**Effective:** July 1, 1999.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 12-15-13-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 1999]: **Sec. 7. The office shall base reimbursement to a federally**  
4 **qualified health center (as defined in 42 U.S.C. 1396d(l)(2)(B)) on**  
5 **one hundred percent (100%) of the federally qualified health**  
6 **center's reasonable costs.**



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
