

SENATE MOTION

MR. PRESIDENT:

I move that Senate Bill 6 be amended to read as follows:

- 1 Page 1, line 5, delete “hazardous waste generated by a person
- 2 who” and insert “**waste generated by a conditionally exempt small**
- 3 **quantity generator (as defined in 40 CFR 261.5).**”.
- 4 Page 1, delete lines 6 through 9.
- 5 Page 1, line 16, after “funded” insert “:”.
- 6 Page 1, line 16, before “from” begin a new paragraph and insert
- 7 “**(1)**”.
- 8 Page 1, line 18, strike “.” and insert “;”.
- 9 Page 1, after line 18, insert “**(2) from the solid waste**
- 10 **management fund established by IC 13-20-22-2.**”.
- 11 Page 2, line 9, after “and” insert “**recycling or**”.
- 12 Page 2, line 14, reset in roman “transportation”.
- 13 Page 4, line 40, after “and” insert “**recycling or**”.
- 14 Page 6, line 3, after “and” insert “**recycling or**”.
- 15 Page 6, line 7, after “and” insert “**recycling or**”.
- 16 Page 6, after line 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 17 “SECTION 9. IC 13-20-20-7 and IC 13-20-20-12 ARE
- 18 REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999].
- 19 SECTION 10. IC 13-20-30-13 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 20 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]:
- 21 Sec. 13. The board ~~shall~~ **may** adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to
- 22 implement this chapter.
- 23 SECTION 11. IC 13-11-2-104 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
- 24 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1999]:
- 25 Sec. 104. (a) "Household hazardous waste", for purposes of IC 13-
- 26 20-20 **and IC 13-21**, means hazardous waste generated by households
- 27 **that:**
- 28 (1) is ignitable (as defined in 40 CFR 261.21);
- 29 (2) is toxic (as defined in 40 CFR 261.24);
- 30 (3) is reactive (as defined in 40 CFR 261.23);
- 31 (4) is corrosive (as defined in 40 CFR 261.22); or
- 32 (5) otherwise poses a threat to human health or the environment.

1 (b) "Household hazardous waste", for purposes of IC 13-21, means
2 solid waste that:
3 (1) is generated by households; and
4 (2) consists of or contains materials that are ignitable, corrosive,
5 reactive, or toxic.
6 © For the purposes of subsection (b), a material is:
7 (1) "ignitable" if the material has the quality of ignitability (as
8 defined in 40 CFR 261.21);
9 (2) "corrosive" if the material has the quality of corrosivity (as
10 defined in 40 CFR 261.22);
11 (3) "reactive" if the material has the quality of reactivity (as
12 defined in 40 CFR 261.23); and
13 (4) "toxic" if the material has the quality of EP toxicity (as
14 defined in 40 CFR 261.24).
